Updates from Valerie Taylor, Founder, CRP

On 7th June I accompanied Khokon and Ayesha, his wife, to Herstmonceux Castle in Sussex where we had been invited to speak to a group of students from Queens University, Kingston, Ontario, Canada. Beth Richan, who had worked at CRP with a group of students some years back, had arranged this annual visit to the Castle, which is the property of Queens University in Canada.

CRP Rajshahi Regional Centre's orientation program
